The programs analyze, as a function of frequency, most linear "transmission-type" networks, with an input and an output. MARTHA includes, besides R, L, and C, sixteen controlled sources; operational amplifiers; mutual inductance; three transistor models and the possibility of easily creating others; ideal transformers; several composite pi and tee structures; and a few exotic elements such as gyrators. For high-frequency applications MARTHA has several microwave elements, including TEM transmission lines, waveguides, attenuators, and isolators.
